ASX Release
Drilling started at Tandarra
ELA awarded priority at Kingston

Navarre Minerals Limited (ASX:NML) announced that drilling commenced yesterday at its Bendigo North Gold Project, 40 kilometres north of Bendigo.

A 2,000 metre air-core program is drilling several geophysical targets interpreted to represent quartz reefs hidden below the clays and sands of the Murray Basin cover at the Company's Tandarra prospect. This program precedes a larger \$4.2 million, 50,000 metre drill program scheduled for October 2011 to May 2012.

Elsewhere in Victoria, the Company has lodged an application and has been awarded priority for an exploration licence (ELA5380) covering 185 square kilometres of the prospective Landsborough Fault adjoining the southern end of the Company's Kingston Gold Project (Location map attached). The application area is 30 kilometres east of Stawell and incorporates the Landsborough Goldfield and the historic Glendhu and Wimmera gold mines.



