

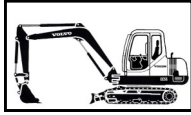

**Navarre Minerals Intersects Broad Zone of  
Gold Mineralisation at Tandarra Prospect**

Stawell-based gold exploration company Navarre Minerals Limited (ASX Code: NML) announces a Reverse Circulation ("RC") drill result of 24m at 2.5g Au/t from a depth of 35m down-hole in drill hole RCT006, including 3m at 10.9g Au/t and 1m at 15.3g Au/t (Table 1), at the Company's Tandarra prospect. This result is from the first drill traverse across the Tomorrow Anticline as part of a 25,000 metre resource definition drill program at the Tandarra prospect, part of the Company's Bendigo North Project, 40 kilometres north of Bendigo Victoria, Australia

RC resource definition drilling commenced on 19 December, 2011 as follow up to recent high grade air-

core drilling results in gold bearing quartz reefs below shallow cover at the Tandarra prospect. Data obtained from this RC program is intended to enable the estimation of a maiden mineral resource at Tandarra by the end of 2012.

"We are particularly pleased with the width of gold mineralization intersected in RCT006 and its relatively shallow depth from 35m down-hole as it aligns with our concept target of a mineral resource that may be suitable to potential open pit mining", commented Geoff McDermott, Navarre's Managing Director.

Navarre is targeting gold mineralisation below a thin veneer of sand and clay cover ranging in thickness from 20 to 50 metres.
