# High grade gold intercept from Navarre's Tandarra Prospect

**STAWELL** - Stawell based gold exploration company, Navarre Minerals, has announced a further high grade drill intercept at its Tandarra Prospect north of Bendigo.

The intercept reported last week was one metre at 33.6 grams of gold per tonne at a depth of 44 metres on the Tomorrow line of quartz reef.

This high grade reverse circulation intercept is contained inside a four metre interval grading 9.4 grams of gold per tonne, approximately 160 metres north of the best intercept to date. This being 34.4 grams of gold per tonne over a 10 metre interval in an air-core hole.

In addition, a further broad intersection of gold mineralisation was encountered with 25 metres 0.8 grams of gold per tonne, including six metres at 1.9 grams per tonne from 41m down hole, which is located approximately 160 metres south of the best intercept drill hole.

Navarre is conducting a 25,000 metre RC drilling campaign targeting shallow goldbearing quartz reefs at Tandarra and is seeking to build a mineral resource at the project by the end of 2012. A diamond drill rig is also currently in operation to help define the geology of the Tandarra prospect.

"We are encouraged by the broad zone of shallow mineralisation in RCT025 as it now links approximately 320m of wide zones of mineralisation in the RC results, which themselves are part of the 2.5km of confirmed strike established by previous AC drilling," Geoff McDermott, Navarre's Managing Director said.

Navarre believes that the mineralisation at Tandarra is analogous to the Bendigo Goldfield, approximately 40kms to the south, insofar as nuggety high grade gold is dispersed throughout an envelope of lower grade material.

"We are particularly pleased by the high grade result in RCT050 as we expect to find high grade gold results as our drill density increases in this style of mineralisation," Mr McDermott said.

With this result, the Tandarra prospect has now returned eight assay results of greater than 20 grams of gold per tonne, including four intercepts at above one ounce per tonne.

"This result is extremely exciting as it confirms our belief that we will intersect high grade gold within a broader halo of gold mineralisation along the 2.5km strike length of the three shallow

central reefs at Tandarra that we are currently drilling," Mr McDermott said.

Given the relatively shallow depth of the gold mineralisation, Navarre is working to establish whether an open pit operation is feasible as a means of mining the high grade gold within a broader envelope of mineralised material.

"Tandarra was identified by modern exploration techniques, which see through the covering sediments, and followed up by inexpensive scout AC drilling. Our challenge now is to define the major gold-bearing reefs near surface and to investigate the quartz reefs which repeat at depth, much as they do at Bendigo and other Victorian goldfields."

Navarre Minerals expects to release more drill results from 25 RC holes at Tandarra that have been completed but await assay results, as well as further RC and diamond holes to be drilled.
