Miner reveals new copper, gold opportunities

A Wimmera exploration company has located an emerging copper belt in western Victoria and says it has big potential.

Stawell-based company Navarre Minerals has released its plans to the Australian Securities Exchange for new copper and gold opportunities along a 130-kilometre volcanic belt.

The area stretches from Stawell to south of Hamilton and is called the Miga Arc.

In an investor presentation released this week, the company says there is opportunity for the discovery of giant deposits and the setting is similar to a volcanic arc in South America, boasting of one of the largest copper systems.

Navarre plans to conduct drilling and further studies to explore the potential.
