



Navarre planning more drilling near Grampians

Navarre Minerals says it is planning more drilling to explore a big volcanic belt near the Grampians.

The Stawell-based company was granted an exploration licence for Tatyoon, south of Ararat, last month.

In its report for the three months to September, Navarre said it had now identified gold at the site which is within a short trucking distance to Stawell's processing facility.

The exploration company has also extended its drilling program at its Eclipse prospect, near the Grampians.

The company said it had seen encouraging copper and gold results from shallow depths but was planning to explore deeper areas later this year.

Navarre said it was also planning to apply for a grant under the Victorian Government's new \$15 million TARGET Minerals Exploration program.
