



Miner Navarre to boost western Victorian copper, gold search

A Stawell-based exploration company says it is stepping up its testing for minerals in western Victoria over the coming months.

Navarre Minerals started drilling for copper at its Eclipse prospect near the Grampians early last year.

In its latest quarterly report the company said it had continued to find broad intervals of copper and gold mineralisation and was now expanding its surveying further south.

Navarre also recently registered its interest for a co-funded drilling program at Eclipse through the Victorian Government's \$15 million TARGET program to boost minerals exploration in the state.

The company also said it had applied for permission to begin drilling for gold in the Stawell corridor, south of Ararat, which it hoped to begin in the coming months.
