Big year ahead for Navarre Minerals

NAVARRE Minerals Limited started a major drilling program targeting gold at five projects in central and western Victoria.

Up to 25,000 metres of drilling will be carried out over the next six months with the majority at the Irvine and Tandarra projects.

This year promises to be the company's most expansive field season to date, with first-pass aircore drilling of 1,200 metres starting at the Stawell Granite Gold Project and drilling expected to start at the Irvine Gold Project in two weeks.

There are 8,000 metres

of aircore, reverse circulation and diamond drilling planned at Irvine targeting Stawell-style mineralisation.

Diamond and reverse circulation drilling recently resumed at the Tandarra Gold Project, which is funded and managed by Catalyst Metals Ltd under a farm-

out agreement.

Up to 12,000 metres of drilling will be carried out targeting repetitions and extensions of Bendigo/Fosterville style high-grade gold.

First-pass programs at the St Arnaud and Glenlyle projects will also start progressively in the coming months.
